

## What you can recycle

Recycle all of your paper, card, cans, plastic, cartons and glass together in your wheelie bin or recycling bags or boxes.

### Household plastic packaging

#### Yes please...

Plastic containers of any size or colour, including:

- Yoghurt pots
- Food trays
- Ice cream tubs
- Margarine containers
- Fruit punnets
- Plastic bags
- Magazine wrapping



#### No thanks...

- Liquid waste
- Food waste (this goes in your food caddy)
- Foil-lined packets (sweet wrappers and crisp packets)
- Black sacks, bio-degradable and degradable bags
- Polystyrene packing or beads
- Tupperware containers
- Plastic furniture

### Drink cartons

#### Yes please...

- Wax-lined, poly-lined and foil-lined cartons (such as milk cartons, Tetra Pak)



#### No thanks...

- Liquid waste
- Food waste (this goes in your food caddy)

### Mixed paper and cardboard

#### Yes please...

- Newspapers, magazines and catalogues
- Telephone directories / yellow pages
- Envelopes (including windowed)
- Junk mail
- Office paper (including coloured paper)
- Wrapping paper
- Shredded paper
- Cardboard and cereal boxes (flattened)
- Corrugated card
- Egg boxes



#### No thanks...

- Soiled paper/tissue
- Wallpaper
- Waxed paper
- Foil backed card
- Card with padding or bubble pack

### Metal tins and cans

#### Yes please...

- Drink and food cans (please rinse)
- Aerosol cans (fully emptied)
- Aluminium foil (clean and dry)
- Metal screw tops and bottle tops



#### No thanks...

- Paint tins
- Any other metals

# What you can recycle



## Mixed glass bottles and containers

### Yes please...

- Drinks bottles – mixed colours
- Food jars

### No thanks...

- Pane or toughened glass
- Mirrors/broken glass
- Light bulbs/fluorescent tubes

## Plastic bottles

### Yes please...

- Plastic bottles of all kinds, including:
- Mineral water, cordial and cooking oil bottles
  - Milk bottles
  - Coloured and clear fizzy drinks bottles
  - Bleach and cleaning fluid bottles
  - Shampoo and shower gel bottles
  - Detergent and fabric conditioner bottles

### No thanks...

- Liquid waste
- Food waste (this goes in your food caddy)
- Polystyrene packing or beads
- Food storage containers
- Plastic furniture



## You can also recycle the following in your separate food and garden waste recycling collections

## Green garden waste

### Yes please...

- Grass cuttings
- Weeds
- Dead flowers
- Garden prunings
- Leaves
- Bark

### No thanks...

- Soil
- Plant pots
- Stones
- Large tree cuttings
- Food Scraps
- Any other general rubbish



## Food waste in your caddy

### Yes please...

- Fruit and vegetables
- Meat and fish
- Tea bags and coffee grounds
- Bread and pastries
- Dairy products
- Rice, pasta, beans
- Eggs and eggshells
- Cooked and leftover food

### No thanks...

- Plastic bags
- Cooking oil
- Food packaging
- Carcasses (whole chickens or turkeys)
- Animal waste
- Nappies
- Garden waste
- Any other non-food waste



## Please don't put your food recycling in plastic bags

You can use biodegradable caddy liners, or put food straight into the caddy.
