How does it work?

Recycle to earn Green Points

Camden has been split into five communities – North West, North Central, North East, Central and South – with each community having their rubbish and recycling monitored. When your community is wasting less and recycling more (compared to the same time last year) you'll be rewarded with Green Points. Green Points are used to determine which individuals and communities win prizes, so the more you accumulate, the better!

Do more and earn extra Green Points

You will be able to earn more Green Points by doing extra things, such as reporting what you've recycled each week. Head to the website at **camden.gov.uk/recyclingrewards** to get involved and tell us what you've done.



What are the rewards?

Rewards for you

Every month the resident who has earned the most Green Points for their community will get a £30 voucher, with a range of vouchers to choose from.

Recycling Rewards card

Once you've activated your account we'll send you a Camden Recycling Rewards card within 28 days. You can show this in over 100 local businesses to get exclusive discounts – check out the list sent with your card or find it online camden.gov.uk/recyclingrewards.





Rewards for your community

After six months, there will be £5,000 to split between the five communities, with the community that has earned the most Green Points receiving the biggest share. You can view the charity shortlist online and vote for your favourite at **camden.gov.uk/recyclingrewards** to decide where the money goes.

Your green wheeled bin, box or reusable bag

You can recycle all of the following items:



The following items cannot be recycled in your green wheeled bin, box or reusable bag:

- Nappies
- ✗ Cooking oil*
- X Paint tins*
- ★ Light bulbs/
 fluorescent tubes*
- ★ Electrical items**
- ✗ Glass e.g. mirrors or broken glass
- X Black sacks

- X Polystyrene
- **X** Tupperware
- X Liquid waste
- Card with padding or bubble pack
- ✗ Plastic toys or furniture
- X Coffee cups
- X Foil lined packets

- * These items can be recycled at the Reuse and Recycling Centre at Regis Road, NW5 3EW.
- ** Small electrical items can be recycled at street recycling facilities across the borough. Visit camden.gov.uk/recycling for more info.

Live on an estate?

Use your reusable green bag to collect recycling in your property, before emptying the contents into your communal recycling bin.

Live in a flat above a shop?

You are provided with clear plastic bags for your recycling, please leave these at the kerbside on your collection day.

Your green caddy and brown food waste bin

Use your kitchen caddy to collect food waste inside your property then transfer it to your outside food waste bin or communal food waste bin.

You can recycle all kinds of cooked and uncooked food, including:

Please don't put food waste in plastic bags as they don't break down. Use compostable caddy liners or put food straight into your caddy - you can rinse it if it gets dirty!
